

Declaration of Conformity with Regulation (EC) 2019/1021 (POPs)

Persistent organic pollutants (POPs) are chemicals that persist in the environment, bioaccumulate through the food web, and risk causing adverse effects on human and the environment. In 2001, the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants was adopted and included the list of persistent organic pollutants. This group of priority pollutants includes:

- 1) Pesticides (such as DDT);
- 2) Industrial chemicals (such as polychlorinated biphenyls, PCBs);
- Unintentional by-products of industrial processes (such as dioxins and furans).

These pollutants can be transported across international boundaries far from their sources, even to regions where they have never been used or produced. The European Union is concerned about the continuous release of POPs into the environment. Therefore, further measures need to be taken in order to protect human health and the environment against those pollutants. The requirements related to elimination, restriction or limitation are summarised in Regulation (EU) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 on persistent organic pollutants.

REPLAST Produkt s.r.o., as a processor of recovery substances, is dedicated and fully committed to the successful implementation of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 (POPs). To the best of its knowledge, REPLAST Produkt s.r.o. hereby confirms that substances, processes and raw materials used or produced during the manufacture of boards and traffic marking components

- Do not intentionally contain POPs;
- 2) Do not use equipment containing POPs;
- 3) Do not exceed the limits defined for unintentional trace contaminants of POPs.

This declaration is based on analyses and statements provided by our suppliers. Moreover, we would like to inform that REPLAST Produkt s.r.o. is constantly monitoring regulatory updates of the POPs regulation and performs research and development of alternative: processes, substances and suppliers, in order to guarantee to our customers continuity, high quality and performance of our articles.
